I mean she NEVER complained, I suppose that generation didn't complain much given that they didn't have the conveniences we have today. But another memory that stands out in the crowd is when I read her the seashell book. I read it to her every sunday along side her bed. She loved it and we always cried together at the end. There are so many more memories, every sunday she would cook macaroni and gravy with meatballs, sausage and neckbones sometimes even brizole. She was the best book. And baker, I loved her cheesecake and pound cake especially. She would also make lamb cakes for Easter and a wonderful ham alongside her specialty pasta, but my most favorite memory of all was spending news years eve with her about 28 years ago with my fiance. We had a blast, we always spent new years eve with her and Christmas Eve. Well there are so many memories they can fill a book. Rest in peace my beloved grandmother, Frances. I love you!
