You were my brother.....until we sing our next duet in heaven.....I Love You

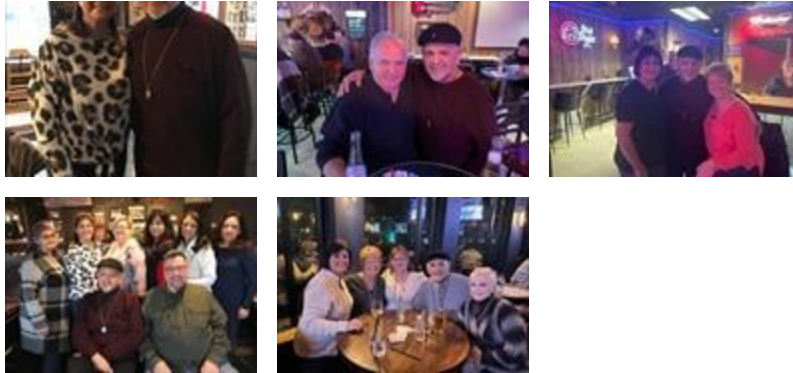
There's a light, a certain kind of light

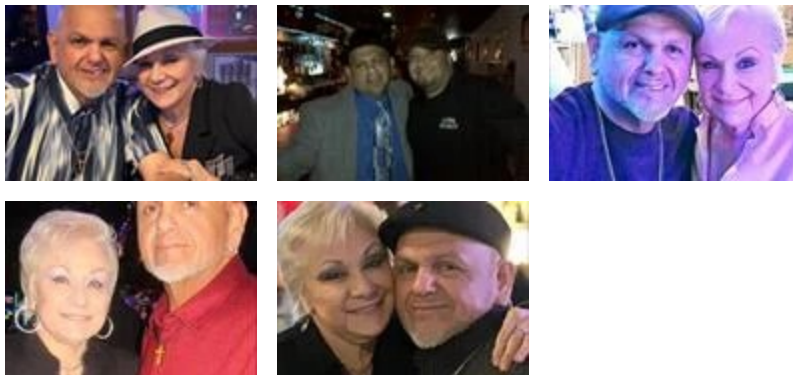

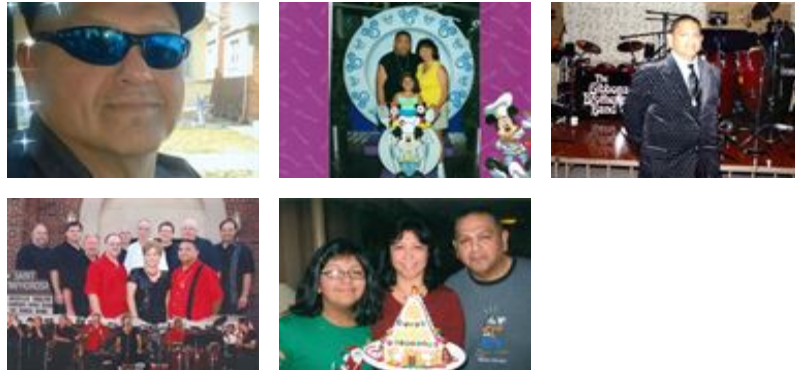
