It was so sad watching her waste away as she grew weaker by the day... The last day , the hospital called she was getting weaker.. I got to hospital around 8 am and she could barely breath. It was like she was breathing like a fish out of water.. She died half past 2 pm in my arms. I was hugging her and holding her in my arms as the tears rolled down my face. I could feel her take her last breath. I called for help and the hospital just listened to her heart and said she gone.. The hospital let her die. She was eating and drinking and they gave her so much sedation that she couldn't eat or drink. Eleven days she layed their dying why no one at hospital, the state, police. No one would help.. If she was ready to die it wouldn't took 11 days no food or water.. That is murder if you ask me but hospital labels it as hospice. So they kill people by starvation and call it hospice.. I don't understand.. When she died me and Mom were alone.. She was gone and I felt holiness in the room. I knew the angels came to take her to be in heaven. I felt like my Oma , Opa, you and my Dad were their in the room.. I had a big picture of you by her bed so she could see your face and I taped your pictures on inside of her bed rail so she could see your face... I feel the pain of a orphan. I hold the memories of all of you in my heart.. When they opened your vault and I seen your casket. I felt a huge relief that you would take care of her now.
