May 2, 1923 - January 22, 2013

Maria H. Ryan, age 89, of Fairborn, Ohio, passed away Tuesday, January 22, 2013 in the Hospice of Dayton. She was born May 2, 1923 in Chicago, IL, the daughter of the late George and Theodora (Cowta) Hyniuk. Maria was a graduate of Kelly High School in Chicago, Class of 1941, Northern Illinois University, Class of 1945, and Loyola University in Chicago.
