Nick James Zografos, age 85, passed away peacefully on Easter Sunday at home with family by his side. He is survived by his devoted wife of 57 years, Lorraine (nee Gleatis). Immediately upon graduation, Nick was inducted into the Army during the Korean War. Upon returning to civilian life, Nick formed Peco and Associates, Inc., a consulting civil engineering firm, which, after sixty years, is still in existence today. Nick was also a life member of both the Order of Ahepa Chapter #323 and the Argo-Summit Masonic Lodge #1133.
