“ Journal letter written by Ann Ulrich

*At age 3, I moved to Chicago with my parents Jack & Gladys Quillin. I was the youngest of five children. At every opportunity, the family returned to Iowa. We attended every special occasion we were able to. Mom worked full-time, so during summer vacations in our grade school years, Mama & Papa let us come stay with them. These months provided us with many happy memories of life on the farm. Phyllis (Haler?) was still home when we behaved, she was a good friend and she took us along gathering eggs and picking berries. Mama kept Phyllis's wicker rocker, dolls and buggy there for when us children visited. Vic taught us to get the cows and mil them. We especially enjoyed when he took us along on the tractor! Sometimes he took us along to get the mail down by the cheese factory. And when he was busy, we had to walk down the gravel road barefooted, or down the back pasture way and cross the creek to get the mail. We loved everything at Steinhart's and playing with Ray and MaryKay. Many times Mary let us stay for dinner or supper and she baked the best pies. All the other aunts and uncles also let us spend a few days with them and being with my cousins was great fun. Mary G. didn't appreciate me climbing almost to the top of the barn with Roger who was only about two years old. A couple summers, Dad couldn't get enough time off work to get us to the farm or perhaps pick us up at Marquette on McGregor with a sack lunch. One of the uncles usually met us there. If not, we had an hour or so to kill, walking around this old river town, until the puddle jumper left to complete our journey to Waukon. I guess the tracks and train station in town are now gone. One summer, Frank and I each took home with us on the train a tiny, newly weaned kitten in shoeboxes. We fed them with doll bottles. These definitely These definitely were the good old days.*

*In Chicago, it always made Gladys and Jack happy when we all got together at each other's homes for Christmas. Mom took many, many group pictures of her 14 grandchildren. Much to the dismay of the other cousins, Brian sometimes entertained us with his accordion. Encores were never requested.*
